- Each exhibit must be the work of the exhibitor and have been completed in the last 9 month
- Exhibitors must not show an exhibit which has previously been shown at a Newcastle Regional Show.

Each item on the entry form should have an identifiable description of the exhibit & fee payment. No late entries will be accepted, and no refund of entry fees will be given.
